

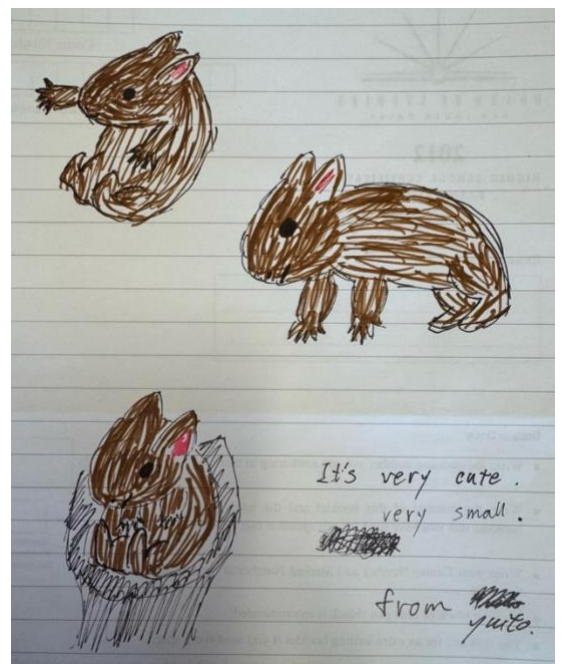


## International School visits Wombatised



Head Start school is a Japanese international school with Australian teachers. It is a School to help expand the younger students knowledge and their English

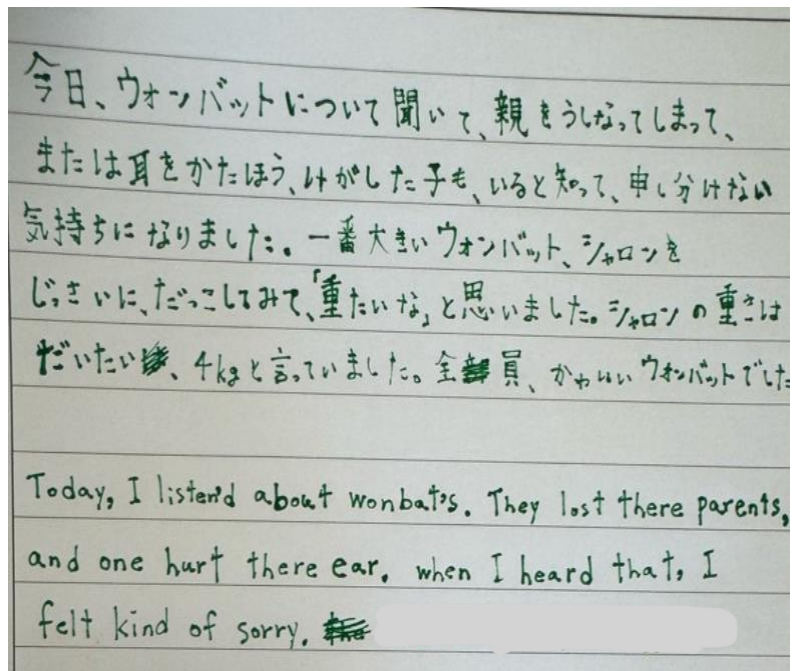
Recently a class visited Wombatised. They learned so much while having heaps of fun and enjoying their time around the grounds.

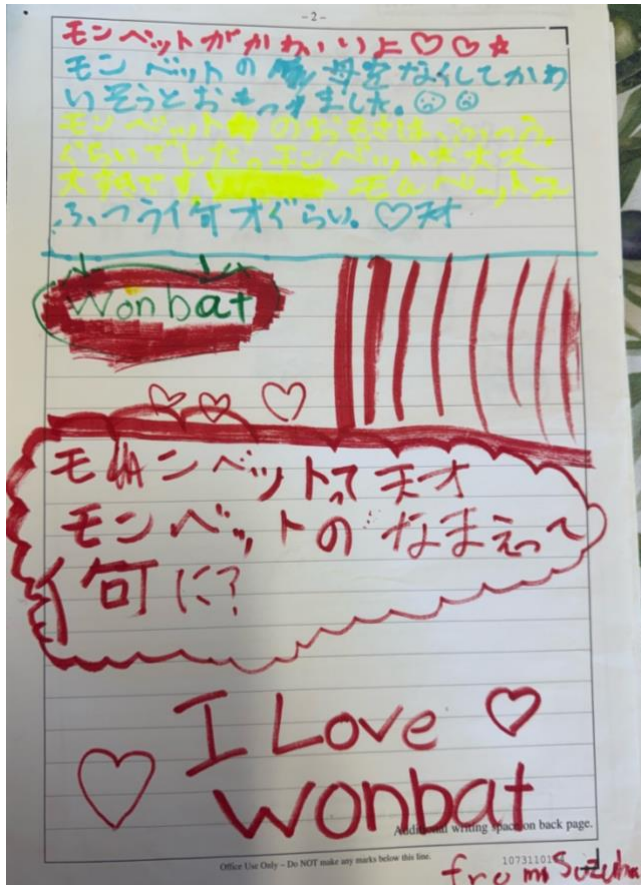
